



#### 1. Live Screencast

Traditional classroom teachers record their computer-based classes from beginning to the end. The recorded screencast video is known as Live Screencast.

- 1. Length of the video
- 2. Clear voices

The flipped classroom is a pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a course are reversed. Short video lectures are viewed by students at home before the class session, while in-class time is devoted to exercises, projects, or discussions.
